Funding Requests

Andrew Bressler was selected for State All Star football this July in Aberdeen. The cost is \$300. He requested a donation to help for the cost. Mary moved to donate \$100, Jan seconded and the motion carried.

Brenda Hendricks and Jenni Hall from the BH Gold Swim Team described a swim camp that they are organizing this summer. They are bringing a national level coach for the camp which will be held June 6-9. The BH Gold Swim Team has 70 swimmers including 10 in high school. They raise funds by holding the swim meet and swimathon. Usually they hold Skate Night at the Rec Center but were unable to since TMone is using the Rec Center this year. They requested a donation from the booster club to help offset the expense of the swim camp this summer. It was decided that we will review our by-laws on donating to organizations, ask the swim team to request a specific amount and discuss this further at next month's meeting.

Coaches' Reports

Eric Ligtenberg, girls' golf coach, reported that 13 girls are out for golf including 10 high school and 3 middle school girls. Money received from the Queen City Classic was used to purchase new polo shirts and equipment to practice indoors.

They had a winter tennis camp for 5 players that was sponsored by the Spearfish Tennis Club. The Queen City Classic money was used to purchase uniforms for the boys and warm ups for the girls.

Exercise Equipment: It was suggested that the booster club consider purchasing exercise equipment specifically for athletes. A location for the equipment would need to be determined to contain the designated equipment.
